

# **2009 Tasar “Bush” Regatta July 11-12 at Lake Wenatchee, WA**

## **Directions to the Lake Wenatchee State Park campsites**

FROM HWY 2 turn North onto Hwy 207 at Coles Corner. Turn-off to "South Entrance" (sites #1-100) is 3.5 miles.

For those needing accommodations for Friday night, there will be additional campsites secured at the park. Notify the park ranger attending the entrance that you are participating in the Tasar Regatta and you will be referred to the appropriate site.

## **Storage of Trailers**

Ranger Rick writes:

“All sailboat trailers will need to be parked off of the designated parking areas adjacent to the south beach. An area designated by cones along the beach will be made for trailer parking. I believe that you will all be launching your boats by hand from the beach, so this should be the best accommodation for you. “

We may come up with alternate/refined arrangements once we are on site Friday. Tony Norris will be there to help direct you Friday and Saturday morning.

## **Saturday Social**

After racing on Saturday, there will be a potluck/Bar B-Q at one of the shelters in the park. Bring items to grill and possibly a salad or desert. Condiments, non alcoholic beverages, and chips will be provided. Feel free to bring additional goodies.

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 CYA prescriptions will apply as well as the rules of the participating classes and this notice of race

**2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category "C"

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club and/or a member of their North American Authority
- 3.2 Eligible classes are: International Tasar

**4 FEES**

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$20.00 US

**5 SCHEDULE**

- 5.1 Racing for all classes will take place on Saturday, July 11 and Sunday, July 12, 2009
- 5.2 Registration will take place on Saturday, July 11, 2009, between 0900 and 1200 hrs at the south end of Lake Wenatchee.
- 5.3 Skipper's meeting will be at 1230 hrs
- 5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start of the first race on July 11<sup>th</sup> is 1300 hrs. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first start of the first race on July 12<sup>th</sup> is 1000 hrs. No races will be started after 1400 hrs on July 12<sup>th</sup>

**6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 6.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration on July 11, 2009

**7 VENUE**

- 7.1 The venue for this event will be the Lake Wenatchee State Park. The sailing will take place on Lake Wenatchee

**8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 8.1 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be in effect

**9 SCORING**

9.1 The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply

9.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series

9.3 (a) When 4 races or less have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores

**10 THE COURSES**

10.1 The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat or at the preparatory signal for each class

10.2 The courses to be sailed are as follows: all marks to be left to port unless a gate is used at the leeward mark, in which case boats may round either of the gate marks

10.3 Course diagrams will be included with the sailing instructions along with the code flags used to designate the courses.

**11 PRIZES**

11.1 Prizes will be given as follows: top three places and probably last place

**12 CHARTERS**

12.1 There will be no charter boats available

**13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk
